

Virtual Maryland Arts Summit FAQ

What are the dates of the Maryland Arts Summit?

The Maryland Arts Summit will run from Tuesday, May 26 through Friday, May 29th

Is there a registration fee?

No, the entire Summit is available free of charge. All you have to do is register.

Where can I find the Summit schedule?

The program includes over 40 sessions in addition to several creative conversations and creative keynotes.

What online platform are you using?

We are using [Crowdcast](#) as our virtual Arts Summit platform (except for a few select sessions that are using google meeting - which is notated in the schedule)

What is the process for registration?

Registration is done by day and time block, **not** by individual session

What are the registration steps?

1. Head to the [MD Arts Summit Main Page](#)
2. Scroll down to "Registration" tab and click the drop-down button
3. Click on Register for Summit Day X (1,2,3, or 4)
4. Click on the Register and Enter MD Arts Summit registration direct link
5. Click on the green "save my spot" button (top right)
6. Enter your email and click "join event"
7. Enter Name, Organization (optional), and county of residence (optional)
8. This must be done for **each day & time block** you are interested in attending

How do I know that I have successfully registered?

1. After filling out your registration information (including email), you will receive an email notifying you of the date and time block you registered for.
2. On the actual event day, you will receive an email approximately 10 min before the start of the session with a direct link for that corresponding time block.

Is advanced registration required?

No, registration can take place before, during and after Summit Sessions (sessions are recorded and available for consumption after the live event).
